

Lockdown Drill

Each year we hold a Lockdown Drill in Term 2 and an Evacuation Drill in Term 4. This is to ensure that staff and students know what to do in case of an emergency and gives us a chance to review our processes and iron out any problems. The Lockdown Drill consists of a warning siren, then all staff and students must be inside a building with the doors locked and windows shut until they receive the all clear.

Reading Fluency in Years 3 – 6

There are five essential elements to Reading: Phonemic Awareness, Phonics, Fluency, Vocabulary and Comprehension. Recently we were successful at achieving a place in a program called, Quality Teaching Strategy. Our project is to work with a mentor school to improve Fluency in Year 3 - 6 students. Reading Fluency is the ability to read a text accurately and with appropriate speed and is an important bridge between decoding and comprehension. Each child has been recently assessed, and we are now working with our mentor school to devise and implement an improvement plan. We look forward to making some great gains for students in this area.
