THE STUDY

Maths is a subject that students tend to have very strong opinions about one way or another. One of the most important and interesting studies on parental beliefs and their impact on how students view their maths ability was conducted over 30 years ago.

In this study, researchers from The University of Michigan administered a series of questionnaires to children aged 10–15 years old and their parents. They wanted to see how powerful parental attitudes and expectations were and if these varied between parents of sons and parents of daughters.

THE MAIN FINDINGS

- 1 A child's opinion of their own ability and expectation of future success was **heavily shaped** by what their parents thought about them. This actually had more impact than the child's previous grades in that subject. Essentially, they **believe their parents more than their grades**.



- 2 Out of the two, the **attitudes and beliefs of mothers** towards their child's educational abilities had **more impact** than the father's.

- 3 Parents of daughters thought that **maths was harder** for their child and that they would have to **work harder to do well** in it compared to parents of sons. This belief was held by both mothers and fathers.

- 4 Parents of sons thought **advanced maths** was more important for their child than parents of daughters.
