## Fremantle Prison Excursion

On Monday 2nd of December 2024, Room's 5 and 6 went on an excursion to Fremantle Prison. As a place of active historical inquiry, Fremantle Prison has a wealth of information and stories for students studying Western Australian History.

Fremantle Prison played a major role in the development of the Swan River Colony. As the seat of the convict system - it influenced the development of the colony for more than 50 years. The work of convicts changed the face of Western Australia through extensive building projects, land clearing, and infrastructure development such as roads, jetties and wells. The forced labour of the convicts was organised and centrally controlled from Fremantle Prison. The students have been learning about the significance of the prison during their history lessons this term and in Week 9 they eventually got to go there.

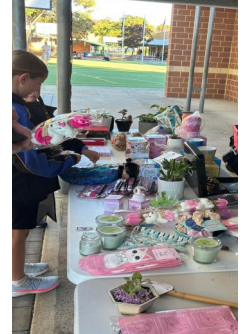
## Thank you for 2024 and we're looking forward to big year in 2025

## Uniform Shop

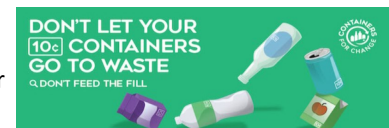
